Champions Ride Days Race Team: Success at the Creek

After an eventful lead up to Round 1 Formula Xtreme, Champions Ride Days Race Team only had 1 rider Dylan Mavin (although injured) representing them. With Jackson Leigh-Smith still recovering from his crash in Tasmania, the Team were hopeful for some results to mirror all the dedication, hardwork and energy they all had put in.

Dylan qualified equal 3rd on Sat with 1.37.574. With Kevin Curtain and Mike Jones in his sights, the 3 races on Saturday were awesome! Dylan displayed racing beyond his years, with great riding, late braking and determination (given his knee injury). Coming 3rd overall on Saturday in the Red Baron FX National Series the Champions Ride Days Race Team Honda CBR600 put it to all the Yamahas!



Team Owner Scott Osborne said "After the past few weeks we were looking for some joy at Eastern Creek and Dylan was awesome. He demonstrated great racecraft up against Kev Curtain, determination considering he was still injured and the racing was great to watch! Can't wait to see it on TV again!!"

After a 3rd overall on Saturday, Dylan lined up again to qualify on Sunday for the Australian FX Superbike Championship with a 1.37.848 and 5th on the grid. With unusually hot weather for a March day, it was going to be tight racing!

"At last Champions Ride Days Race Team has the results we knew we were able to achieve" Team Manager Stephen Fong said "it was just unfortunate that Dylans knee wasn't quite right yet, but showed he is a force to be reckoned with and that the Team have a great set-up and bike preparation."

On Sunday, the racing was fast and furious, Kev and Dylan diced for the lead and gave all the spectators something to cheer about. The race pace was extreme with Dylan posting his best time during Race 1 with 1.36.252. Dylan finished 4th, 2nd, and 2nd which meant he finished equal 2nd overall but 3rd on countback!!
