In Q1, Jackson Leigh-Smith was putting some very fast lap times down. Whilst moving up the leader board and on a great lap, he was undertaking a back-marker, when he lost the front in Turn 1. With the threat of a broken pelvis and being out for the season, the Teams morale was low.



Team Owner Scott Osborne said "We all know the risks of racing, and enjoy being competitive and trying to be as fast as possible. So when we saw Jacko injured it was a real low for us all. Thankfully we later found out his pelvis was not broken, but previous injury scarring they could see".

With all eyes and hopes on Dylan now, he was out to better his Q1 time of 9th on the grid. With all the Team on the wall supporting him and holding the board out, they were passed by Dylan who then also crashed in qualifying, into the airfence on the main straight.

"Dylan made remarkable progress quickly considering he has never ridden at Symmons Plains before" Team Manager Stephen Fong said "it was just unfortunate that the crash in qualifying twisted his knee. He tried to ride on Sunday, but did not have the strength in it to race".
